

AP Terms Booklet Project

You will complete a comprehensive booklet of 15 AP terms from the 1st semester's vocabulary. Your booklet should have a cover page, a table of contents, and should display a clear theme throughout the booklet. Each page of your book will focus on a specific AP term from the 1st semester, preferably a term that you don't remember or that you struggled with. Try to use terms from both quarters. You will need to define, explain, and give at least three examples accurately expressing each term. Each page should have some sort of visual component that expresses the term or conveys an idea related to the term. First, include a cover page that provides the title, your name, teacher's name, class/period, date (MLA heading) and an appropriate illustration to represent the theme of your booklet. Second, provide a table of contents with all of your terms and the page numbers they can be found. Third, create a page for each term that you have selected, that includes a picture, definition, and at least three examples that accurately portray the term on the page. You can find examples of the terms from the Vocabulary packets and the Modes and Schemes packet that have been provided, in any of the works we have covered 1st semester, or from any other sources you can find. Lastly, create an artistic and clever booklet that neatly and uniquely displays the terms that you have chosen for the project.

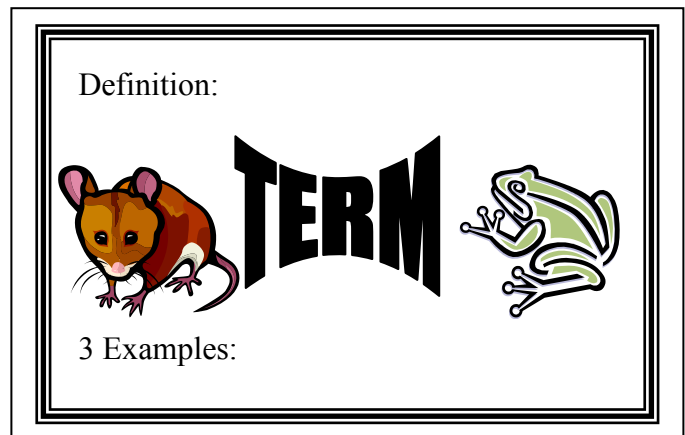
- All words are listed alphabetically
